# Important information, please read carefully

As a practice, we are pleased to offer travel vaccinations and travel health advice. Please, see attached form for details of charges.

Those travelling on package deals to popular tourist resorts are less at risk of travel related diseases than those "trekking" to many countries or for a prolonged length of time, and those that are likely to be some distance from medical aid.

Anyone planning prolonged travel for more than 3-4 weeks i.e trekking, please contact us as early as possible to allow us sufficient time to plan your travel vaccination programme. For routine holiday vaccination enquiries, please contact us 2-3 months in advance. Please, note that it may take up to 14 days to process.

If unable to contact us well in advance, or unable to attend appointments that we are able to offer, you can book an appointment with R S Occupational Health Ltd. If you contact them on tel 01463 513 100, they will be able to explain their charges and appointment system.

# KINGSMILLS MEDICAL PRACTICE FEES AND CHARGES

Some services provided by the GP Practice are not covered under our contract with the NHS and therefore attract charges. Examples of Non-NHS services for which the GP can charge their patients are: Certain travel vaccinations, Holiday cancellation claim forms, Private medical insurance reports, Letters requested by, or on behalf of, the patient. (The fees charged are based on the British Medical Association suggested scales).

#### Travel Vaccinations:

Yellow Fever (no prescription required – obtained at practice)

£85.00

The following vaccines are <u>NOT covered by NHS</u> arrangements and therefore attract a charge. We charge £15.00 for the private prescription plus £15 for each appointment to administer the vaccine course. The full cost is payable on collection of the prescription. (We can include up to 3 items on a private prescription).

In addition to our charges, there will be a charge for buying the vaccine from the Pharmacy – prices vary so it can pay to shop around.
